No. 21/07/2015-5L/1597963 To enable the employees working in the Shops and Commercial Establishments situated in the State of Punjab who are voters of Haryana to cast their votes in Haryana, it is considered in public interest to declare 21st October, 2019 as a paid holiday within the revenue jurisdiction of the districts adjoining the areas of Haryana State.

Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by second proviso to sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Punjab Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1958 (Punjab Act No. 15 of 1958) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to fix Monday, falling on 21st October, 2019 to be a 'closed day' for the employees who are voters of Haryana working in Shops and Commercial Establishments in the districts adjoining to the State of Punjab. However, 21st October, 2019 (Monday) shall not be a 'closed day' in lieu of weekly off falling between 20th October, 2019 and 26th October, 2019.
