ORDER

In continuation of our earlier order No.LDR/JUD-21/2019-20/18687-787 dtd 25th Mar/2020 , and pursuant to extension of lock down till 3rd of May/2020 by Govt of India, all the restrictions imposed and exemptions allowed during the lock down which commenced on 24th of March' 2020 in the district shall continue as it is , except for the following exemptions as approved by the State Cabinet dated 13th April/2020 and MHA order dtd. 15th April/2020.

EXEMPTIONS:-

1. All Government offices in the district shall commence their working w.e.f. 20th April 2020. While all Group 'A' and Group 'B' officers shall attend the office, and MTS and other officials below Group A/B will attend in rotation system in the capacity of 33% of strength.

All other National directives for COVID-19 management and SOP for social distancing in office, compulsory wearing of masks/face covers in office shall be strictly followed;

2. Agriculture, Horticulture and activities such as Tea-Garden and MGNREGA related works to resume in the district considering the sowing and harvesting season. Whereas, compliance to protocols laid down by Health department to be ensured and no new workers/labourers shall be allowed from outside district.

Strict compliance with social distancing policies, cleanliness, personal hygiene and mandatory use of face masks to be followed.

3. Construction /infrastructure related works where workers are already available at the work site would be allowed to resume the work. No new workers will be allowed from outside the district/state. No new construction activities shall be allowed except the ongoing and incomplete works. No brick kiln within the township shall operate in compliance with MHA order.

Permissions of DC to be obtained by for commencement of work giving all details of the construction activity including the labour present at work site , location of work site , raw material requirements and material to be transported to or from Assam or any other place from Arunachal Pradesh.

4. No movement of Private vehicles will be allowed except Agricultural use vehicles like Tractors, Power Tillers, Mini Trucks and bi-cycle. However, these vehicles will not be

allowed to use for ferrying passengers except the driver and helper in case of Tractors and Mini-Trucks.

Further, issue of POL to above vehicles shall be regulated and issue for agriculture purpose only with limited POL items as fixed subject to production of RC book and EPIC of vehicle owner (s).


5. Strict monitoring of Check post/entry points and regular patrolling of porous border to be conducted keeping in view the possibility of un-authorised entry/migration through inter-state porous borders.
6. Distribution of essential ration commodities shall be continued through door to door services as arranged vide order No.LDR/JUD-21/2019-20/316-376 dtd. 3rd Apr/2020 until further order.
7. Other Industrial establishments outside the Jurisdiction of municipality/township (rural areas) shall not operate without the due permission from the district authority, routed through the Deputy Director, Industries/ ADTH/DFO (T) in case of saw and veneer mills.
Industrial establishments within the jurisdiction of municipality/township shall remain closed in the district as per the direction of MHA, GoI.
8. All transport services including APST services within the district will remain suspended.
9. All places of worship shall be closed for public. No religious congregation will be permitted.
10. All social/political/sports/entertainment/academic/cultural/religious functions/gathering shall be barred.
11. In case of funerals, congregation of not more than 20 (Twenty) persons will be permitted. Prior permission should be obtained from competent authority.
12. All educational training, research, coaching institutions etc. shall remain closed until further order.
13. Hospitals, veterinary Hospitals and all related medical establishments such as dispensaries, Chemist, Pharmacies and medical equipment shops, laboratories, ambulance etc. will remain functional in the district.
14. Any individual who steps out of their homes will have to wear mask or any kind of face cover mandatorily and non compliance shall be booked as per sec 16 A of the Arunachal Pradesh Epidemic Disease (Prevention of COVID-19) Regulation 2020 as notified by AP/HFW-12/2020 Dtd Itanagar the 17th April 2020
