## OFFICE OF DISTRICT MAGISTRATE, PANCHKULA

#### ORDER

In continuation of the order dated 18.05.2020 issued by this Office vide Endst. No. 12117-66/MA/MC-I, Dated 18.05.2020, it is ordered that

Whereas, under directions of the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), guidelines on lockdown measures to contain the spread of COVID-19 in all parts of the country were issued vide order of even number dated 24.03.2020 under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 for a period of 21 days with effect from 25.03.2020. Under further directions of NDMA, the lockdown period was extended for a further period of two weeks with effect from 04.05.2020 vide Order Number 1-29/2020-PP datec 01.05.2020 and consolidated revised guidelines were issued vide Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 01.05.2020 by the NEC for implementation upto 17.05.2020.

Whereas, in exercise of the powers under Section 6(2)(i) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, NDMA has issued an Order number 1-29/2020-PP dated 17.05.2020 directing the Chairperson, NEC that lockdown measures be continued to be implemented in all parts of the Country upto 31st May, 2020. In compliance of orders of NDMA dated 17.05.2020 NEC has issued detailed guidelines for the measures to be taken by Ministries/Departments of Govt. of India, States/Union Territory Governments and State/Union Territory Authorities for containment of COVID-19 in the country upto 31.05.2020, and State Executive Committee, Haryana has extended the lockdown period in the state of Haryana till 31.05.2020 vide order no. DMC-SPO-2020/5688, dated 17.05.2020.

In furtherance of order dated 23.03.2020 issued by this office vide Endst. No 6300-54/MA/MC-I, dated 23.03.2020, Order dated 05.05.2020 vide Endst. No.10970-11015/MA/MC-I, dated 05.05.2020 and in compliance of the order issued by Govt. of Haryana vide letter No. DMC-SPO-2020/5688, dated 17.05.2020 and by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India order no 40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) dated 17.05.2020 and to contain the transmission of COVID-19 disease, the orders under sections 30 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 are hereby made to regulate the operations of the activities in the territorial jurisdiction of the district Panchkula, which are summarized as:

- The following activities will continue to remain prohibited for the period of two weeks with effect from 18.05.2020.
- All domestic and international air travel of passengers, except for medical services, domestic air ambulance and for security purposes or purposes as permitted by MHA.
- ii. Metro rail services.
- iii. Schools, Colleges, educational/training/coaching Institutions etc. will remain closed.
  Online/distance learning shall continue to be permitted and shall be encouraged.

- iv. Hotels, restaurants and other hospitality services, execept those meant for housing health/police/Government officials/healthcare workers/stranded persons including tourists and for quarantine facilities; and running of canteens at bus depots, railway stations and airports. Restaurants shall be permitted to operate kitchens for home delivery of food items.
- v. All cinema halls, shopping malls, gymnasiums, sports complexes, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars and auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places. Sports complexes and stadia will be permitted to open however, spectators will not be allowed.
- vi. All social/ political/ sports/ entertainment/ academic/ cultural/ religious functions / other gatherings and large congregations.
- vii. All religious places/places of worship shall be closed for public, Religious congregations are strictly prohibited.
- viii. Use of Community Centres is disallowed keeping in view the ban on social gathering.
- For the operation of the activities in the territorial jurisdiction of the district Panchkula it is ordered that:
  - (i) All the activities related to the essential commodities like grocery items fruit, vegetables, Milk booths, bakery confectionery items shall remain open in all days from 07:00 AM to 06.30PM
  - (ii) All the shops in the internal Sector Markets in Panchkula town will be allowed to open from 09:00AM to 06:00PM on all days except every Monday. There will be strict emphasis on implementation of social distancing norms and other precautions, which must be ensured by the shop owners.

All the standalone (single shops, neighborhood/colony shops and shops in the residential areas shall remain open on all days except Monday from 09.00 AM to 06.00PM.

Note:- It is clarified that from all the booths in the internal sector markets, the activities will be carried out not from inside the booth but from the distance i.e. owners will have to tie up the rope on the pillars in the corridor in front of the booth and customers will come and stand up in the queue outside the corridor on the circle put up by the owner itself.

It is further clarified that owner/operator of the booth will be held accountable for the purpose as above.

- (iii) The Rehri Markets of Sector 7, 9, 11, 17 and shops/establishments in other areas like Railly, Abheypur, Haripur, Maheshpur, Budhanpur, Banna, Madanpur, Jaisinghpura, Bhainsa Tibba etc. will remain open in the manner given below:-
  - A. All shops facing eastern and northern side will remain open from 09:00 AM to 06.00 PM on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday.
  - B. All shops facing western and southern side will remain open from 09.00 AM to 6.00PM on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

- (iv) Markets of Kalka/Pinjore town (MC area) will remain open as per schedule given below:-
  - All shops facing eastern or northern side will remain open from 08:00 AM to
     02.00 PM on all days, except, every Monday.
  - All shops facing western and southern side will remain from 12.00 PM to
     6.00PM on all days, except every Monday.
- (v) All shops situated in rural areas will remain open from 08.00AM to 06.00PM on all days.
- (vi) Sweet shops and Bakeries will be permitted to open. However, they will not be allowed to provide any dining facility within their premises. Home delivery of cooked/packed food will be allowed.
- (vii) The restaurants will be permitted to operate only for home delivery of cooked food i.e. only the activities from the kitchen portion of the restaurant is allowed and for that strict hygienic procedure will be followed.
- (viii) The operation of the barber shops, saloons, spas etc. will remain suspended.

# IT IS TO BE NOTED THAT THE ACTIVITIES ALLOWED UNDER THESE ORDERS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED IN THE CONTAINMENT ZONES

As per National directives for COVID-19 management, the following are the lockdown measures to be complied with for public and the Work Places-

## Measure at Work Place:-

- Wearing of face cover is compulsory in all Public and work places and adequate stock of such face covers shall be made available.
- II. All persons in charge of work places shall ensure social distancing as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, both within the work places and in company transport.
- III. Social distancing at work places shall be ensured through adequate gaps between shifts, staggering the lunch breaks of staff, etc.
- IV. Provision for thermal scanning, hand wash and sanitizer preferably with touch free mechanism will be made at all entry and exit points and common areas. In addition, sufficient quantities of handwash and sanitizer shall be made available in the work places.
- V. Frequent sanitization of entire workplace, common facilities and all points which come into human contact e.g. door handles etc., shall be ensured, including between shifts.
- VI. Persons above 65 years of age, persons with co-morbidities, pregnant women and children below the age of 10 years shall stay at home, except for meeting essential requirements and for health purposes.
- VII. With a view to ensuring safety in offices and work places, employers on best effort basis should ensure that Aarogyu Setu is installed by all employees having compatible mobile phones.

VIII. Arrangements for transport facilities shall be ensured with social distancing, wherever personal/public transport is not feasible.

### Measures at Public Places-

- I. Wearing of face cover is compulsory in all public place and work places.
- II. All persons in charge of public places and transport shall ensure social distancing as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
- III. No organization/ manager of public place shall allow gathering of 5 or more persons.
- IV. Marriages related gatherings snall ensure social distancing, and the maximum number of guests allowed shall not be more than 50.
- Funeral/ last rites related gatherings shall ensure social distancing, and the maximum numbers allowed shall not be more than 20.
- VI. Spitting in public places shall be punishable with fine, as may be prescribed by the State/ UT local authority.
- VII. Consumption of liquor, paan, gutka, tobacco etc. in public places is not allowed.
- VIII. Shops selling liquor, paan, gutka, tobacco etc. will ensure minimum six feet distance

  (2 gaz ki doori) from each other, and also ensure that not more than 5 persons are present at one time at the shop.

#### **USE OF THE AAROGYA SETU**

Shopkeepers/Street Vendors shall display public notice regarding downloading "Aarogya Setu Mobile App" for public/customer awareness and motivate them to install the same and regularly update their status on the app. The shopkeepers will ensure that all the employees must install Aarogya Setu Mobile App and use the same regularly.

 All establishments shall ensure permanent paint marking outside and inside their premises. These marks shall be trade 1m apart and it shall be ensured that persons visiting and working maintain social distancing by means of those marks. They shall also ensure that no vehicle is parked outside their shops so as to allow enough space for people to stand as per markings.

All the concerned are hereby ordered to comply with the directions above. Any violation of these instructions/orders is liable to criminal prosecution under section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005.
