CURFEW ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 CrPC.
(No.C&S.3/2009/PT.II/153 Dated Shillong, the 25th April, 2020)

Whereas, in view of the prevailing situation concerning COVID - 19 in the state, country and globally;

Whereas, to put in place preventive and mitigation measures to identify and take more stringent steps so the pandemic of COVID - 19 is contained, reduced and eliminated in East Khasi Hills District and Meghalaya, by way of ensuring observance of strict protocols of the Advisories issued by Government of Meghalaya in the Health & Family Welfare Department;

Now, therefore, I Smti. M. War Nongbri, IAS, District Magistrate, East Khasi Hills District, Shillong in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 144 Cr. P.C. read together with Regulation 3 of the Meghalaya Epidemic Diseases, COVID-19 Regulations, 2020 do hereby promulgate **CURFEW** in Shillong Agglomeration and adjoining areas with effect from 06:00 AM of the 26th of April, 2020 (Sunday) up to 06:00 AM the 4th of May, 2020 (Monday); -

AREAS TO BE UNDER CURFEW:

1. Whole of Municipal Area
2. Whole of Cantonment Area
3. All Census towns areas under Mawlai Block
4. All Census towns areas under Mawpat Block
5. Areas under Myllem Block from Umshyrpi Bridge upto 7th Mile, Upper Shillong.
6. Madanring, Mawblei, Laitkor, Nongkeh, Umlyngka, Lawsohtun, Mawdiangdiang, Diengiong, Siejiong.

This Order will Not apply to

1. Security Forces
2. Medical Teams on duty
3. Wholesale and Retail Pharmacies
4. Police and Armed Forces
5. Fire & Emergency Service
6. MeECL & Power Grid
7. Food and Civil Supply Department
8. FCI
9. Public Works Department (PWD)
10. Public Health Engineering (PHE) Department
11. A.H and Vety Department and Meghalaya Directorate of Dairy Development
12. Shillong Municipal Board
13. Sanitization Division of Shillong Cantonment Board



14. Postal Service, Telecom, Communications & IT Services
15. Press, Print & Electronic Media
16. Banks, ATM & Treasuries
17. Petrol Pumps
18. Essential services including Health Services home delivery of LPG Cylinders, home delivery of essential/household items, online food delivery, online services delivery, courier services
19. Authorized workshops and designated spare parts dealerships of Health and Family Welfare Department, Govt. of Meghalaya
20. Government Officials on Duty.

These services shall strictly comply with all protocols and procedures including social distancing, disinfection and other advisories of Government in the Health Department, WITHOUT FAIL.

Also, movement of vehicles carrying essential commodities, security forces, medical equipments & goods vehicles are also exempted. However, Drivers and attendants of the vehicles shall be subject to medical screening as per laid down protocols.

This Order will not affect the arrangement of Fair Price Shops, Identified Wholesale Traders, Identified Local Retailers and Commercial and Private establishments as allowed to operate vide No.POL.75/2020/Pt-I/20, dated 23.04.2020:


- i. Shops Dealing in Essential Goods as notified by Political Department, Government of Meghalaya vide Order No.POL.75/2020/Pt.I/13 dated 21/04/2020, No.POL.75/2020/Pt.I/23 dated 24/04/2020 and No.POL.75/2020/Pt.I/25 dated 24/04/2020.
- ii. Courier Services for essential goods as notified by Political Department, Government of Meghalaya vide Order No.POL.75/2020/Pt.I/13 dated 21/04/2020
- iii. E-commerce operations in essential goods as notified by Political Department, Government of Meghalaya vide Order No.POL.75/2020/Pt.I/18 dated 22/04/2020
- iv. Common Service Centres as notified by Political Department, Government of Meghalaya vide Order No.POL.75/2020/82 dated 22/04/2020
- v. Services provided by self employed persons, e.g., electrician, I.T. repairs, plumbers, motor mechanics and carpenters.
- vi. Shops for repair of trucks on highways.
