No. SRM-DRA(DDMA)COVID-19 Dated, Nahan, the 15th June, 2020

ORDER

Whereas, pursuant to the Union Home Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India's order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 30th May, 2020 and the Hon'ble Chief Secretary-cum-Chairperson, SEC, Himachal Pradesh's order No. Rev(DMC)(C)20-2/2020-COVID-19 dated 31st May, 2020, a detailed order for ensuring strict compliance of the directions of the Government(s) has already been issued vide this office order dated 31st May, 2020.

Whereas, the Government of India vide letter No. 40-01/2020-DM-I(A) dated 12th June, 2020 and the Hon'ble Chief Secretary-cum-Chairperson, SEC, Himachal Pradesh vide letter No. Rev(DMC)(C)20-2/2020-COVID-19 dated 14th June, 2020 have issued some additional directions/amendments regarding movement of persons between "Night Curfew" and quarantine requirements which have been made a part of this order.

Whereas, the infection of Corona Virus is continuously posing threat to human life and all care needs to be taken to prevent the impact of this virus. Moreover, all agencies involved to contain the virus should take all measures to overcome/contain the infection.

Therefore, I, Dr. R. K. Pruthi, IAS, District Magistrate, District Sirmaur, Nahan in exercise of powers conferred under Section 144 (1)(2) of the Cr.P.C., 1973 do hereby order and direct that:-

1. The movement of individual(s) shall remain strictly prohibited **between 08:00 PM to 06:00 AM (Night Curfew)** throughout the District except for essential activities, but the restriction does not apply to instances of loading/unloading of goods (as part of supply chains and logistics); buses carrying persons and trucks and goods carriers plying on State and National Highways; or persons travelling to their destinations after disembarking from buses, trains and flights.

(A) The Government of H.P. vide its order dated 14.06.2020 has added and amended the following points in its order dated 31.05.2020 regarding quarantine requirements and these orders shall be followed strictly:-

i) The persons covered under SOPs issued dated 23rd May, 2020 for inter-state movement of industrial workers, industrialists/factory owners, traders, raw material suppliers, service providers, inspecting authorities will be exempted from purview of Home Quarantine.

ii) The persons visting the State for bonafide purpose of trade, business, job, project, service purpose, commission agents and arthiyas with supporting documents and entering the State with valid permit/epass and not coming from high covid-19 case load cities and other containment zones from rest of the country will also be exempted from the purview of quarantine.

iii) The management, incharge or head of any NGO of any charitable organization, which has branches in the State and travels to the State of Himachal Pradesh in connection with its affairs or for an official meeting, for a short duration not exceeding 48 hours and don't mix with general masses, follows all social distancing and other Covid-19 prevention protocols/norms, does not organize any social/cultural or any other gathering of any sort, shall be exempted from quarantine requirement.

iv) The use of Aarogya Setu app shall be mandatory in all cases, including the above exempted categories.

(B) Point No. (i) from the section Quarantine Requirements has been amended as under:-

(i) All persons coming from high case load COVID-19 infected cities will be institutionally quarantined. Only for exceptional and compelling reasons such as cases of human distress, pregnancy, death in family, serious illness, persons above 65 years of age with co-morbidities and parent(s) accompanied by children below 10 years may be permitted to be home quarantined, instead of institutional quarantine for 14 days provided that such home quarantine facility is available to follow all covid protocols.

(C) Point No. (viii) from the section 'Quarantine Requirements' has been replaced as under:-

(i) The migrant labourers coming in the State can be sent directly to the work site of the Orchardist/Agriculturist/Contractor/Project Proponents. The labour can start working at these sites immediately subject to observing all the due precautions including social distancing/isolation and the constant monitoring for sysmptoms, as is being done for quarantined persons. The period of active surveillance shall however continue to be the

same as per the period prescribed by the guidelines issued by the Department of Health & Family Welfare.

Any person(s) contravening this order shall be liable for prosecution under Sections 269, 270 and 188 of IPC and Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005.

This order shall come into force with the date of issuance and shall remain enforced till further orders.
