In continuation of this office letter no. 15181-200/MA dated 31.05.2020, keeping in view of the latest guidelines received from the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi vide no.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 29.06.2020 and Govt. of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Chandigarh vide no. SS/ACSH/2020/506 dated 30.06.2020 it is hereby order that:-

1. Movement of Buses and Vehicles

- a. All types of goods/ cargo carriers shall be allowed including empty trucks. – 24x7
- b. All movement of ambulances & vehicles of medical professionals, nurses, paramedical staff, sanitation staff and others on essential/ emergency duty/ COVID19 duty including police, magistrates, fire, electricity etc. shall be allowed – 24x7
- c. Inter – state and intra- state movement of buses would be allowed without any restriction. Transport vehicles can utilize the entire seating capacity

2. Inter-state movement of persons by domestic flights/trains/buses/cars etc.

Inter-state movement of persons by domestic flights/trains/buses/cars etc. is allowed subject to the condition that the inward passenger would follow SOP of the Health Department. The passengers would be required to either download COVA-app and get self generated e-pass or declare their particulars at the airport/railway stations/ bus stand/ inter-state borders as the case may be.



3. Marriage Functions

- (i) Marriage Functions, Engagement ceremonies, open Air parties etc. in banquet halls, marriage palaces, hotels and open venues are allowed on any day (5 am to 10 pm) with maximum gathering of 50 guests excluding the catering staff.
- (ii) The size of Banquet Hall and venue for 50 persons shall at least be 5,000 sq. feet based on requirement of 10 x 10 area for a person for the purpose of maintenance of adequate social distancing.
- (iii) The Bars shall continue to remain closed. However Liquor can be served in the function as per the Excise Policy of the State.
SOP for hotels and other hospitality units will be followed.
- (iv) No special permission is required for marriage function, engagement ceremonies etc.

4. Funeral/Last rites

No permission is required for the Funeral/Cremation/Last rites/Rasam Pagri/Kirya/Bhog and Antim Ardas. However attendance should not be more than 20 persons.

5. Restaurants

Restaurants are allowed to open till 9 pm with 50% occupancy or 50 guests, whichever is less. Liquor can be served provided the restaurant has a valid permission from the Excise Department . However, Bars shall remain closed.

6. Hotels and other Hospitality Units

(i) Restaurants in Hotels are allowed to serve food including buffet meals upto 50% of their seating capacity of 50 guests, whichever is less. These restaurants would also be open to persons other than hotel guests but the timings, for both the hotel guests as well as persons from outside would be till 8 pm. The bars shall remain closed. However, liquor can be served in the Rooms and Restaurants, as permitted under the Excise policy of the State.

(ii) The guests will be allowed to enter and leave the hotel premises between 10 pm to 5 am based on their schedule of travel by flight/train. The air/train ticket and hotel booking would serve as a curfew pass for one-time movement of these guests to and from the Hotel during the curfew hours (10 pm to 5 am).

7. Weekend Restrictions

- (i) Shops dealing with essential commodities will be allowed to remain open till 8 pm on all days.
- (ii) Restaurants and Liquor Vends will continue to remain open till 8 pm on all days.
- (iii) On Sundays, shops (other than those dealing in essential commodities) and shopping malls shall remain closed.



8. Permits and passes:

- (i) No separate permission would be required by the industries and other establishments to resume their operations. All employees, be it government offices, private offices and other work places, would be allowed to move without any requirement of pass during the permitted hours i.e. 5.00 am to 10.00 pm.
- (ii) Interstate movement of persons- There shall be no restrictions on inter-state and intra-state movement of persons and goods and no separate permission/approval/permit will be required.
- (iii) Use of COVA-app and self generated pass would be mandatory for inter-state passengers.

National Directives for COVID-19 Management, guidelines, Standard Operating procedure (SOP) and advisories issued by government should be strictly followed.

Any violations shall invite criminal proceedings under the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and the Indian Penal Code 1860.

Further relaxations or restrictions if any, will be followed by a subsequent order.
