**Subject: Regarding provision of adequate Covid medical services to ESIC healthcare providers during ongoing resurgence of Covid pandemic**

Sir/Madam,

Please refer to this office letter of even number dated 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2021 wherein approval was communicated to functionalize a minimum of 20% of bed capacity at each ESIC Hospital as dedicated COVID beds for ESI IPs, beneficiaries, staff and pensioner which may swiftly be enhanced as per prevailing local needs.

Further, reference is also cited to previous communications from this office wherein it has been directed to follow Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GoI, guidelines/instructions issued from time to time pertaining to various COVID related matters.

In continuation, competent authority has approved adoption of MOHF&W, GoI, order no. 27-4/2021/DGHS dated 27.04.2021 (copy enclosed) wherein various measures have been identified for making provision of COVID treatment facilities to healthcare providers so as to keep the morale of Covid Warriors high and to enable healthcare providers to attend to their duties without fear and stress.

Accordingly, all measures listed at Para 2.i) to vi) of the said order of MOHF&W are to be implemented in each ESIC Hospital in the best interest of ESIC healthcare providers. Further, in case of 100% occupancy of such arrangement or in case of non-availability of prescribed Covid treatment within ESIC hospital, the MS of concerned hospital will ensure availability and supervised transfer of healthcare worker to other equipped ESIC hospital in the vicinity or to equipped government/private tie-up hospitals.

This issues with the approval of Director General.


**ORDER**

Having regard to the fact that a number of Health Care Providers of various categories working with the Hospitals and the Directorate General of Health Services are acquiring Covid-19 infection while performing their duties. It has been reported to the undersigned that many of them are not getting hospital beds and requisite life-saving emergency treatment. This kind of situation is not only distressing for these patients and their families but also demoralising the remaining workforce.

2. In view of the above, MSs/Directors of all the three Central Government Hospitals are directed as under: -

- i. Identify a suitable site in the Hospital with five to ten beds along with requisite consumables and equipments for attending to such patients (staff patients).
- ii. Admission on these beds shall be done by carefully scrutinizing the patient through the Emergency Department only and this facility shall not be allowed to be misused at any point of time.
- iii. An officer may be designated as Nodal Officer to run and maintain such facility till such time as necessitated by the situation.
- iv. The admitted staff patients must be supported in all possible way, including requisite medical care, drugs and IV fluids, consumables, safe drinking water, protein-rich diet, clean healthy environment, etc. as any other patient would require and get.
- v. Upon admission of the staff patient, the concerned MS/Director must personally watch/oversee the treatment and treatment conditions at such sites on daily basis.
- vi. Every effort must be made to establish two-way communication with the attendants/family of the staff patient, as one would do for any other patient.
- vii. In case, admission at such site is not feasible because of 100% occupancy, the MS/Director of the concerned facility must find out the availability of such beds at similar sites in other hospitals, and if bed is available there, the staff patient shall be transported in a suitably equipped ambulance under the care of a qualified healthcare professional so as to maintain the continuity of care en-route.

3. This is issued in the interest of Covid Warriors with a view to keep their morale high so as to enable them to attend to their duties without fear/stress.
