ORDER


In continuation of the order of even number dated 07-05-2021 and in exercise of powers conferred under Section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Chairman, State Executive Committee, hereby issues clarification to Clause 8 (regarding movement of goods) of the revised guidelines to break the chain of COVID 19 transmission in the State, as below.

Clause 8: Unrestricted movement of all types of goods and cargo (outside containment zone):

- a. All facilities in the supply chain of essential goods, whether involved in manufacturing, wholesale or retail of such goods through stores, or e-Commerce companies shall be allowed to operate adhering to National Directives for COVID 19 management.
- b. Movement of all types of goods including empty goods vehicles

Clarification: At the ground level different interpretations are being made on the types of goods exempted, which is hindering smooth flow of supply chain of goods.

Hence, it is re-iterated that there shall be no restrictions on movement of goods and goods would also includes finished goods in inventory of manufacturing units/warehouses.
