(UNDER THE SECTION 144 OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE 1973)

Whereas, the Chairperson, State Exective Committee has issued order under refrence no.5 and imposed restrictions in the State to break the chain of transmission of the COVID 19 virus,

And whereas the State Government is satisfied that the State of Maharashtra continues to be threatened with the spread of COVID 19 virus;

And whereas new variants like delta, delta plus etc. have come to spread and are fuelling the potentiality of imminent (4-6 weeks), more severe third wave of Covid-19 with wider geographical area;

And whereas INSACOG (a consortium of laboratories for Whole Genome Sequencing in the context of Covid 19 pandemic) has intimated that Delta Plus Variant is currently a Variant of Concern (VOC) with following characteristic :

1. Increased transmissibility
2. Stronger binding to receptors of lung cells
3. Potential reductions in monoclonal antibody response;

And, Whereas these mutations to the virus and its continual evolution may lead to unforeseen situations, requiring wider and stricter restrictions, so triggers other than Oxygen Beds Occupancy have been promulgated;

And whereas, the virus causing Covid 19 is undergoing mutations in various geographies and that these mutations are displaying more transmissibility and potential reductions in monoclonal antibody response, the level trigger, irrespective of values of the indices of weekly positivity rate and oxygen bed occupancy percentage, to remain at a level of 3 is to be in operation till further orders,

Whereas, District Disaster Management Authority, Nagpur in its meeting dated 25.06.2021 resolves, to put more restrictions in various activities carried out in the district.

Therefore, in exercise of the powers, conferred under section 2 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and The Disaster Management Act, 2005, in the capacity of Chairperson of District Disaster Management Authority, Nagpur I, Ravindra Thakare, Collector & District Magistrate, Nagpur, hereby issue the order imposing following guidelines /restriction about various activities.

| 1. | Timings for shops/ establishments dealing with Essential Items | Till 04.00 pm (All days) |
| 2. | Timings for shops/ establishments dealing with Non- Essential Items | Till 04.00 pm only on weekdays |
| 3. | Malls/ Theatres (Multiplex as well as Single Screen) / Natyagriha etc. | Closed. |
| 4. | Restaurants | 50% capacity for dining in till 4.00 p.m. only on weekdays (After words Only Parcel / Take Away and Home Delivery) |
| 5. | Local Trains | Restricted for Medical, few essentials and women |
| 6. | Public Places/ Open grounds/walk/ Cycling | 05.00 am to 09.00 am on every day |
| 7. | Opening of Private Offices | All - Till 4.00 p.m. on working days, except Exemption Category |
| 8. | Offices Attendance- Including government offices & private (Exception: Govt offices having Covid related work) | 50% Capacity |
| 9. | Sports | 05.00 am to 09.00 am and 06.00 pm to 09.00 pm (Outdoor only) |
| 10. | Shooting | Bubble, No movement outside post 5.00 p.m |
| 11. | Gatherings (Social/ Cultural/ Entertainment) | 50% capacity of Hall or 50 People (which ever is less) Till 4.00 pm on Weekdays (Function only for 3 hrs) |

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| 12. | Marriages | 50% capacity of Hall or 50 People (which ever is less) Till 4.00 pm (Function only for 3 hrs) |
| 13. | Funerals | 20 People (Function only for 3 hrs) |
| 14. | Meeting/ Elections- GB of local bodies/ cooperative bodies | Online |
| 15. | Construction | Only Onsite labors or labors must leave by 4.00 pm |
| 16. | Agriculture | Till 4.00 pm on all days |
| 17. | E-commerce- Items as well as Services | Regular |
| 18. | Jamav Bandi/ Sanchar Bandi | Jamav Bandi till 5.00 pm and Sachar Bandi after 5.00 pm |
| 19. | Gym/Salon/Beauty Center/SPA/Wellness Centers | Till 4.00 pm, 50% capacity, only by appointment, no AC |
| 20. | Public transport buses | 100% without standing |
| 21. | Cargo Movement (Max three persons (drivers/helpers/cleaners or others) may travel for whole rules for passengers shall apply. | Regular |
| 22. | Inter- District Travel by for passengers either by private cars/taxis/Buses/ long distance trains. | Regular-Except if moving to or passing through with any stoppage in level 5 wherein passenger E-pass is a must. |
| 23. | Manufacturing : Export oriented units Including MSMEs that need to fulfill export obligation | Regular |
| 24. | Manufacturing: 1. Essential Goods Manufacturing Units (Items 91 ontinuous as essential goods and Units producing raw material/packaging for any essential goods & entire supply chain) 2. All 91 ontinuous process industries (Units that require processes that are of such nature that these cannot be stopped immediately and cannot restart without considerable time requirement) 3. Manufacturing of items that are significant to national security and defense 4. Data Centers/ Cloud Service Providers/ IT Services Supporting Critical Infrastructure and Services | Regular |
| 25. | Manufacturing : All other manufacturing units across sectors, which are not covered under essential, 91 ontinuous process or Export oriented units | With 50% Staff Movement with Transport Bubble |
| 26. | Schools, Colleges, Coaching Classes and other Educational Institutions | To remain closed. (However for the purpose of administrative work, exams, online classes, practical exams only administrative establishment can be kept open) |
| 27. | Religious Places | To remain closed (Open for performance of religious duties for the staff that lives within the campus provided isolation bubble is maintained for this staff) |
| 28. | Swimming Pools | To remain closed |
| 29. | Amusement Parks(without watersports) | Till 4.00 pm |
| 30. | Boating | Till 4.00 pm |
| 31. | Libraries, Reading Rooms, study Rooms | Till 4.00 pm |
| 32. | Aadhar card centres | Till 4.00 pm |
| 33. | Skill development institutes of health workers | Till 4.00 pm |
| 34. | Gorewada Jungal safari, Maharaj Bag Zoo, Botanical Garden & Pench Tiger Reserve | Till 4.00 pm |
| 35. | Government/ Semi Government Training Institutes. | Till 4.00 pm |


Note:

1. "Regular" means normal ways of transaction with Covid Appropriate Behavior restrictions and subject to any SOP that may be promulgated by State Disaster Management Authority for various activities.
2. All other activities/conditions other than the ones specified in this order will be in accordance with the previous orders issued earlier by this office and orders under reference.
3. If any person establishment doesn't follow the Covid Appropriate Behavior (Wearing of Mask, Maintaining Social Distancing ,etc) properly or doesn't adhere to the directions/ guidelines maintained in this order, will be liable for strict punishments under Disaster Management Act 2005, Epidemic Disease Act of 1897 and section 188 of IPC Act of 1860. Fines and Penalties will be imposed on the defaulters as per the orders mentioned in references. Offender's licenses or permissions of establishments will be withdrawn for operations till notification for Covid-19 epidemic, remains in force.
4. Every Thursday review of parameters, (I) Positivity Rate and (II) Occupancy of Oxygenated Beds and state level triggers, would be done. Based on these parameters, level of restrictions, would be decided and new order would be issued on every Friday, which would come in force from Monday.

This said order will remain in force throughout the Nagpur District from 7.00 am of 28th June, 2021 till 7.00 am of 5th July 2021.


