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**ORDER**


Dated, Kohima the 17<sup>th</sup> July 2021

No. DCK/CON/COVID-19/2020/Pt/WR-149(A):: In pursuance to the directive issued by the Home Department, NSDMA Government of Nagaland vide No.NSDMA-ER-COVID19-01/2020 (Part-II)/5514, dated 17.07.2021 and in continuation to the this office order of even number dated 13.05.2021, 21.05.2021, 31.05.2021, 11.06.2021, 18.06.2021, 30.06.2021 and 10.07.2021 the following **relaxations** of lockdown regulations- **Unlock Phase-III** are hereby made within Kohima District from **18<sup>th</sup> July to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2021**:

1. **Colleges** in Kohima district are allowed to reopen from 26<sup>th</sup> July 2021 subject to all the teachers and non-teaching staff having been fully vaccinated (taken both the doses) against COVID-19, or having taken the 1<sup>st</sup> first dose of vaccine against COVID-19, and at least 15 (Fifteen) days have passed since taking the 1<sup>st</sup> (first dose) and strict adherence to the SOP including the maximum allowable allowed percentage of attendance of the students in the classes to be issued by the Home Department.
2. **Schools** in Kohima district are allowed to reopen for Class XI and XII, from 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2021 subject to all the teachers and non-teaching staff having been fully vaccinated (taken both the doses) against COVID-19, or having taken the 1<sup>st</sup> (first) dose of vaccine against COVID-19, and at least 15 (fifteen) days have passed since taking the 1<sup>st</sup> (first dose) and strict adherence to the SOP including the maximum allowed percentage of attendance of the students in the classes to be issued by the Home Department.
3. Opening of **in-house skill development institutes/ establishments** with 50% capacity from 26<sup>th</sup> July 2021 will be permitted, subject to all the trainers, assistants and non-teaching staff having been fully vaccinated (taken both the doses) against COVID-19, or having taken the 1<sup>st</sup> (first) dose of vaccine against COVID-19, and at least 15 (fifteen) days have passed since taking the (first dose), and strict adherence to the SOP to be issued by the Home Department.
4. **Social, political, religious, entertainment, academic, cultural gatherings and other public gatherings** in Kohima district are allowed up to a maximum of 50 (fifty) persons when the events are held indoors, and up to a maximum of 100 (hundred) persons when the events are conducted outdoors, and subject to strict adherence to COVID-19 appropriate behaviours and all the applicable SOPs. **However, such functions/ programs are to be organised/ conducted ONLY in venues where appropriate physical distance can be maintained.** In the event of exceptional requirement of holding of function/ program with a larger gathering the prior permission of the Kohima DTF on COVID-19 will be required.
5. Opening of **restaurants for dine-in** in Kohima district up to 50% capacity are permitted, subject to all the attendants/staff of the restaurants having been fully vaccinated (taken both the doses) against COVID-19, or having taken the 1<sup>st</sup> (first) dose of vaccine against COVID-19, and at least 15(fifteen) days have passed since taking the 1<sup>st</sup> (first dose), and strict adherence to the applicable SOPs.
6. The Kohima DTF on COVID-19 shall map areas for micro-containment zones in case the situation so warrants.
7. **The returnees /travellers entering the State/ Kohima District and tourists**, who are asymptomatic and fully vaccinated against COVID-19 will not be required to be tested for COVID-19 at the point of entry or required to quarantine. Those who have taken the 1<sup>st</sup> (first) of the vaccine against COVID-19 and at least 15 (fifteen) days have passed since taking the dose, will not be required to be tested for COVID-19 at the Point of Entry but will be required to quarantine for 7 (seven) days. For all other cases, the persons concerned will be required to undergo testing for COVID-19 on payment as per the Government approved rates at the point of entry and further undergo 7 (seven) days quarantine. **In the event where proper facilities for quarantine at home are not**

8. **Inter-district movement of person** for non-essential service or purpose including private journey by light vehicle is allowed subject to the person(s) including the driver being asymptomatic and having completed their COVID-19 vaccination or taken at least a single dose of vaccine against COVID-19 and 15 days have passed since taking the dose
9. **All shops/ business establishments/ barber shops and Taxis** are to mandatorily display their Vaccination status prominently and shall be allowed to open/ operate as per the Order issued by this Office Dated 10.07.2021.

11. **All other activities which are otherwise not permitted shall continue to be strictly restricted.**


Any action (s) in contravention with the above stated regulation shall deem to have committed an offence punishable under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code and relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005.
