## **ORDER**

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide order read 8 <sup>th</sup> above has directed the State to give heed to Article 21 read with Article 144 of the Constitution of India, and follow the law laid down in the Hon'ble Supreme Court's orders in the Uttar Pradesh case dated 14<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021. In compliance with the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the current situation of the spread of COVID-19 pandemic in the State has been reviewed, and the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairman of the State Executive Committee of State Disaster Management Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 20(3) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, hereby orders the following additional guidelines for strict implementation by the enforcement authorities w.e.f. 00:00 Hrs of 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2021:

- i. The present categorization of Local Self Government Institution (LSGI) regions based on seven day average Test Positivity Rate (TPR) vide G.O. (Rt) No. 524/2021/DMD dated 13<sup>th</sup> July 2021 shall continue. Exemptions and restrictions already applicable to the respective category areas will continue. No additional relaxations shall be granted anywhere under any circumstances.
- ii. There will be complete lockdown on 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> July 2021 (Saturday and Sunday) with the same guidelines as issued for 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> June 2021 vide G.O. (Rt) No. 459/2021/DMD dated 7<sup>th</sup> June 2021 and G.O. (Rt) No. 461/2021/DMD dated 10<sup>th</sup> June 2021.
- iii. District Collectors are directed to identify and demarcate microcontainment zones in all Districts, regardless of the categorization of the LSGI regions, and enforce special intensified stringent restrictions so as to bring down the new cases at the earliest.
- iv. The Health and Family Welfare Department is directed to conduct a mass testing campaign on Friday, 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2021 with a target of 3 lakh tests across Kerala with special focus on Districts where the seven day average TPR is above 10%. Further, the number of daily tests shall also be enhanced urgently to the peak testing capacity for the effective containment of the pandemic.
