ORDER

Whereas, the Government of Meghalaya Home (Political) Department vide order No. POL.75/2020/Pt.I/144, dated 17.09.2021 have permitted additional activities in the State with effect from 20th September, 2021.

Whereas, the COVID-19 situation in North Garo Hills District has considerably improved as compared to previous months.

Whereas, there is growing demand from the Bazaar Committees to allow them to re-open weekly markets as requested by the farmers as the closure of weekly markets is adversely affecting the livelihood activities of the people particularly the marginal farmers / traders and at the same time a petition has also been received from the Dudhnoi Anchalik Merchants Association to re-open the Border Haats and weekly markets in border areas of North Garo Hills District.

And whereas, there are also questions from the parents, public and the Heads of Educational Institutions regarding re-opening of hostels and also to allow more people in funeral gatherings and in engagement/marriage ceremonies outside the places of worship.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the Government order for additional activities issued vide above mentioned order and also in exercise of the powers vested upon me under Section 144 Cr. P.C and relevant provision of Disaster Management Act, 2005, I Shri R.P. Marak, IAS, District Magistrate, North Garo Hills District, Resubelpara do hereby passed the following order as shown below:

1. Opening of Border Haats are permitted on trial basis and subject to compliance of some basic covid protocols such as maintaining 5 feet minimum distance, wearing of masks, practice of hand hygiene etc.
2. Hostels are permitted to re-open with the prior permission of the undersigned and in compliance with the SOP being issued by Education Department.
3. Funeral gathering are permitted upto a maximum number of 50 persons.
4. Engagement/marriage ceremonies outside the places of worship are permitted upto 1/3rd (one-third) seating capacity but subject to maximum number of 100 persons in spacious halls/open areas and 50 persons in private residences.

5. In all these, individuals must maintain a minimum distance of 5 feet and strictly follow all covid-19 safety protocols.

This order shall have immediate effect.
