Order

Date: 03rd October, 2021

Whereas, the COVID-19 has been declared as pandemic by the World Health Organization and National Disaster Management Authority, being satisfied that the district is threatened with COVID-19 pandemic.

Whereas, it is evident that there has been an exponential surge in the COVID cases in the District Gurugram and necessary measures are to be ensured by District Administration to contain the spread of COVID-19 and also to ensure minimum collateral damage to the system.

Whereas, in compliance of the State Disaster Management Authority, Government of Haryana order no. DMC-SPO-2020/10943 & Corrigendum no. DMC-SPO-2020/103134 dated 03.10.2021, in continuation of this office order no. 4050/MB dated 19.09.2021 and in exercise of the powers conferred in me under relevant provisions of the National Disaster Management Act, 2005, I, **Dr. YashGarg, IAS, Deputy Commissioner-cum-Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority, Gurugram** do hereby extend the '**Mahamari Alert-Surakshit Haryana**' (महामारी अलर्ट-सुरक्षित हरियाणा) for another fortnight, i.e. from 04.10.2021 (05:00 am onwards) to 18.10.2021 (till 05:00 am) in District Gurugram along with guidelines to be implemented (during this period) issued vide earlier orders.

The following modifications are provided in earlier orders:-

- I. Fully Residential University in the District are directed to continue conducting classes online till further orders. Matter will be reviewed after some time to decide whether classes in the physical mode will be allowed. In the meanwhile, the administration of the fully residential Universities may endeavour to get all students, faculty members and staff (including the outsourced ones) fully vaccinated and share the progress with the Departments of Higher Education, Technical Education and Medical Education & Research as the case may be.
- II. Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) are allowed to open for students with 100% attendance with strict adherence of requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation of the premises, Covid behavioural norms and guidelines as indicated in the SOPs released by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GOI. Department of Skill Development & Industrial Training, Haryana will release guidelines for implementation of these orders immediately.
- III. In coming months, various festivities will follow one after the other till 31st December 2021 such as Navratri, Dussehra, Milad-Un-Nabi/Eid-e-Milad, Karwa Chauth, Diwali, Govardhan Puja, Bhaiya Dooj, Chhath Puja, Guru Nanak Jayanti, Christmas and New Year's Eve. This is a critical period as there may be a tendency to violate COVID appropriate behaviour during festivals, resulting in large gatherings, events, fairs etc. Therefore, adherence to guidelines to allow festivities in a safe and COVID appropriate manner especially in religious places may be strictly enforced by District administration.



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The following relaxations shall continue as permitted vide earlier orders:-

- a. Colleges and Polytechnics are allowed to re-open for students with strict adherence of requisite social distancing norms, regular Covid appropriate behavioural norms, the guidelines as indicated in the SOPs released by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GOI and regular sanitisation of the premises. Department of Higher Education, Haryana and Department of Technical Education, Haryana will release guidelines for implementation of these orders immediately.
- b. Restaurants and Bars (including in hotels and in malls) are allowed to open with 50% of the seating capacity and adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid-19 appropriate behavioural norms.
- c. Gyms and Spas are allowed to open with 50% capacity after adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid-19 appropriate behavioural norms.
- d. Club houses/restaurants/bars of the Golf Courses are allowed to open with 50% seating capacity with adherence to requisite social distancing and other COVID-19 appropriate safety norms. Members/visitors shall be allowed to play in Golf Courses by the management in a staggered manner so as to avoid overcrowding.
- e. All shops and malls are allowed to open with adherence to requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid-19 appropriate behavioural norms.
- f. Swimming Pools are allowed to open after adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms. All swimmers/practitioners/eligible visitors and staff to preferably get vaccinated with both doses of COVID-19 vaccine.
- g. In indoor spaces, gatherings of upto 50% of the hall capacity are allowed with a ceiling of maximum 100 persons whereas in open spaces gatherings will be allowed upto 200 persons subject to strict observance of Covid-19 appropriate behavioural norms and social distancing measures.
- h. Conduct of entrance and recruitment examinations by different Universities/Institutes/Government Departments and Recruitment Agencies are allowed in the District with strict implementation of "Revised SOP issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GOI dated 10.09.2020 regarding preventive measures to contain spread of COVID-19" as well as guidelines released by Central/State Government/Departments from time to time.
- i. Training centres in Haryana state established under the aegis of Haryana Skill Development Mission are also allowed to open (by staggering of the trainees for maintaining social distancing as per prescribed Standard Operating Procedures and Guidelines issued by Ministry of Home Affairs, GOI, State Disaster Management Authority, Haryana, National Skill Development Corporation and Local Administration from time to time).
- j. Coaching institutions, Libraries and Training Institutes (whether Government or private) are also allowed to open with strict adherence of requisite social distancing norms, Covid appropriate behavioural norms guidelines as indicated in the SOPs released by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GOI and regular sanitisation of premises.



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- k. Religious places are allowed to open with 50 persons at one time with the condition that they follow requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid appropriate behavioural norms.
- l. Corporate Offices are permitted to open with full attendance subject to strict observance of social distancing, Covid-19 appropriate behavioural norms and regular sanitisation.
- m. All production units, establishments, Industries are permitted to function. However they shall strictly adhere to Covid-19 appropriate and prescribed guidelines, behavioural norms and social distancing.
- n. Sports Complex, Stadia are permitted to open for sports activities including for outdoor sports activities except contact sports (spectators will not be allowed). Sports Authorities shall ensure adherence of requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation of the premises and Covid-19 appropriate behavioural norms.
- o. Cinema Halls (in malls and stand alone) are allowed to open with maximum 50% seating capacity with adherence of requisite social distancing norms, Covid-19 appropriate behavioural norms and the guidelines as indicated in the SOPs released by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GOI, as well as regular sanitisation of the premises.

It is also advised that "No Mask-No Service" will be strictly observed in the District. People with face cover/mask only will be allowed to board public/private transport and enter any other government and private establishment for availing any services/goods.

There will be continuous focus on the fivefold strategy for effective management of COVID-19 i.e. Test-Track-Vaccination and adherence of COVID-19 appropriate behaviour.

Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceed against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.
