ORDER

WHEREAS, vide Order No. F.23/Misc/COVID-19/DGHS/NHC/2020/Pt XVIII/811-817 dated 28.06.2021 the keepers of all private hospitals /nursing having total bed capacity of 100 beds or more were allowed to reduce their reserve capacity for COVID oxygenated bed to 30% of their total bed capacity. Further, the keepers of all private hospitals /nursing homes having total bed capacity less than 100 beds were allowed to exercise an option regarding reserving COVID beds in their respective hospitals / nursing homes.


And whereas, due to increase number of cases of vector borne diseases (Dengue / Malaria / Chikungunya) in NCT of Delhi, the keepers of all private hospital having total bed capacity of 100 beds or more were allowed to reduce their reserve capacity for COVID oxygenated beds from 30% of their total bed capacity to 10% of their total bed capacity vide Order No. F.23/Misc/COVID-19/DGHS/NHC/2020/Pt XVIII/2144-51 dated 18.10.2021.

And whereas, it has been observed that the transmissibility of the new variant of SARs- CoV-2(B.1.1.529; named Omicron) is very high and the number of Omicron positive cases in the community is rising exponentially.

And whereas, there has been an upsurge of COVID-19 positive cases in NCT of Delhi in the past four days and the positivity rate has exponentially risen from 2.44% on 31.12.2021 to more than 8% today i.e. 04.01.2022.

Therefore, the keepers of all private hospitals / nursing homes having total bed capacity of 50 beds or more are directed to reserve at least 40% of their total bed capacity (i.e. 40% of Ward Bed capacity and 40% of ICU bed capacity) for COVID patients.

This issues with the prior approval of DGHS-cum-Supervising Authority.

3. Online teaching/distance learning to be encouraged

All Educational Institutions including schools, colleges, universities, coaching institutions etc. shall remain closed. However, these institutions are expected to maintain the academic schedule through online teaching. However, medical and nursing colleges may continue to function normally.

4. Prohibited/Restricted activities

- a) All bars, Cinemas Halls, Multiplexes, Malls, restaurants, spas, museums, zoos etc. shall be allowed to operate at 50% of their capacity subject to all staff present being fully vaccinated.
 - b) All Sports Complexes, stadia, swimming pools, Gyms shall remain closed (except being used for training of sports persons for participation in National/International sports events as well as for organizing National/International sports events). No Spectators or visitors are to be allowed.
 - c) AC buses will run at 50% of capacity.
5. Only fully vaccinated staff will be allowed to attend the Government as well as Private Offices, working spaces, factories, industries etc.

6. Principle of No Mask - No Service

No Service shall be provided in Government or private offices to the persons not wearing proper mask.

Note: The district authorities may impose additional restrictions as deemed necessary, based on their assessment of the situation, but they will not dilute the above restrictions.
