Sub: Amendment to SOPs for monitoring of international travelers arriving from United Arab Emirates (UAE) including Dubai in Mumbai

Ref: 1) Circular No. MGC/F/5819 Dated 29.12.2021

2) Guidelines for International travelers issued by Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare Dated 07.01.2022

To contain the spread of the Omicron variant of Covid-19 in the city, special SOPs for monitoring of international travelers arriving from United Arab Emirates (UAE) including Dubai in Mumbai were issued under circular No. MGC/F/5819 Dated 29.12.2021.

As per these SOPs, 7 days Home quarantine and on arrival RT-PCR test was made mandatory for such passengers. These directives are now revised as below:

- No special SOPs henceforth will be applicable for passengers coming from United Arab Emirates (UAE) including Dubai
- Guidelines applicable to international travelers arriving from "Countries other than Countries at-risk" will be made applicable to travelers arriving from United Arab Emirates (UAE) including Dubai

These directions will be enforced with effect from midnight of 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022.
