Ref: National Draft Policy for Rare Disease, 2020 and Enzyme Replacement Therapy for ESI Beneficiaries.

Madam/Sir,

Rare diseases are health conditions that affect a very small number of people and inspite of their low prevalence they are a major public health problem. This requires a multipronged, multisectoral approach to screen, diagnose, treat and rehabilitate patients suffering from it. Further lack of effective treatment which is exorbitantly costly and may not lead to "cure", prevention needs to be focused by increasing awareness among the health care workers and population at large.

In order to deal with rare diseases ESIC has:

- A. Compiled a booklet "Operational Guidelines for Rare Diseases" (32 pages, copy enclosed) which include:
 - 1) Organizational Structures for:
 - Overall Management
 - Data Collection
 - Training
 - 2) Protocols for:
 - Optimal Screening,
 - Early Diagnosis
 - Management of confirmed or suspected cases
- B. Prepared a Teaching & Training module for health care workers and IEC material for general public, which will be circulated shortly after a pilot run.
- C. A Dashboard is being created at ESIC Hqrs for collection and compilation of data of rare diseases. Till the time it is made functional the field locations are required to collect and compile the data and forward to ESIC Hqrs. as per the above guidelines.

This is for your information, compliance and necessary action/adherence. Monthly compliance of the same be forwarded as per above guidelines.
