Subject: Providing both Covid and non-Covid services in Health Care Institutions: Regarding.

In view of current situation of COVID-19 in Karnataka, both Government and Private Health Facilities shall henceforth make arrangements to provide both Covid and non-Covid services to patients on a daily and continual basis. Hence, Public Notification cited at reference (1) stands withdrawn.

While a minimum number of isolation beds shall be kept for covid admissions, the concerned authorities at health facilities shall ensure that under no circumstance, non-Covid services shall be denied in these hospitals. Infection control measures and Covid Appropriate Behaviour (CAB) shall be complied with, to prevent / minimize the risk of Covid-19 transmission among the health professionals and those who visit the hospitals.
