Order

Keeping in view the larger public interest in the scenario of emerging threat of Pandemic Covid-19 and latest guidelines received from the Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Chandigarh vide no. 7/56/2020/2H4/1296-1297 dated 25.02.2022 (Copy enclosed). I, Gurpreet Singh Khaira, IAS, District Magistrate, Amritsar in exercise of powers conferred upon me under Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, National Disaster Management Act, 2005 and section 144 of CrPC, 1973, in supersession of all previous instructions hereby order the following restrictions shall be in force from 26.02.2022 to 25.03.2022 :-

1. Social distancing and wearing of masks

- a) Wearing of masks by all persons in public places, including workplaces etc. will be mandatory and must be strictly observed and enforced.
- b) Social distancing i.e minimum 6 feet distance (do gaz ki duri) for all the activities shall always be maintained.


2. Educational Institutions

Universities, Colleges (including Medical and Nursing Colleges), Schools Polytechnics, ITIs, Coaching Institutions, Libraries and Training Institutes (whether Government or Private) are allowed to open for physical classes while adopting requisite social distancing norms, regular sanitisation and Covid-19 appropriate behavioural norms. Concerned institutions may advise all the students of age group more than 15 years to have at least first dose of vaccination, while attending physical classes. **Students will have the option to attend online classes.**

3. Principle of No Mask - No Service

No Service shall be provided in Government or private offices to the persons not wearing proper mask.

- Adequate publicity of all above mentioned measures to be done by District Public Relation Officer, Amritsar to ensure awareness among general public regarding COVID-10 Vaccination.
- Vaccination teams where and whenever demanded by office incharges for on the spot vaccination or for regular vaccination camps at places of gathering, would be provided by the Department of Health and Family Welfare.
- Any violation of these guidelines shall be punishable under sections 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 besides legal action under section 188 of Indian Penal Code (IPC), 1860, shall be taken.
