The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 26th May 2022 and is hereby published for general information:-

ACT No. 25 of 2022

An Act to amend the Tamil Nadu State Commission for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Act. 2021.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title and 1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu State Commission for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes commencement. (Amendment) Act, 2022.

> (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 13th day of October 2021.

Amendment of section 17.

2. In section 17 of the Tamil Nadu State Commission for the Tamil Nadu Act Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Act, 2021 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), for sub-section (1), the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:-

17 of 2021.

"(1) The Government may, make rules, either prospectively or retrospectively, for carrying out all or any of the purposes of this Act.".

Substitution of 3. In the principal Act, for the expression "honorarium and expression. allowances" occurring in three places, the expression "salaries and allowances" shall be substituted.

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 26th May 2022 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 26 of 2022

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board Act, 1970.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Short title and Drainage Board (Amendment) Act, 2022.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Tamil Nadu Act 4 of 1971. 2. In section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Amendment of Board Act, 1970, in sub-section (1), in clause (c), for items (iv) and (v), section 4. the following items shall be substituted, namely:—

"(iv) Rural Development;

(v) Water Resources;".

ACT No. 27 of 2022

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act. 1994.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventh-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Panchayats (Amendment) Act, 2022.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In section 104 of the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in sub-section (1),-

(1) for the expression "by the Inspector" the expression "by the Inspector or by any other officer authorised by the Government in this behalf " shall be substituted:

(2) for the first and second provisos, the following proviso shall be substituted, namely:-

"Provided that in making a transfer under this sub-section, the Inspector or any other officer authorised by the Government, may issue such general or special directions as may, in his opinion, be necessary for the purpose of giving due effect to such transfer.".

3. In section 106 of the principal Act, the following proviso shall Amendment of be added, namely:---

"Provided that in the case of Secretary of a village panchayat, the power under this section shall be exercised by an officer authorised by the Government in this behalf.".

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 26th May 2022 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 28 of 2022

1 Act to provide for the appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commenced on the 1st day of April 2022.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 2022.

2. The State Government may appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commenced on the 1st day of April 2022, a sum not exceeding Three Lakhs Sixty Four Thousand One Hundred and Seven Crores Two Lakhs Thirty Nine Thousand rupees, which shall be inclusive of the sum of Two Lakhs Forty Four Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Crores Seventy Three Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand rupees specified in section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2022, being moneys required to meet--

- (a) the grants made by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for the year, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No.4) Act, 2022. Short title.

2. The sum specified in column (5) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to seven hundred and thirty three crores twenty nine lakhs twenty eight thousand three hundred and ninty four rupees shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to meet the amounts spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2013, in excess of the amounts authorised or granted for those services and purposes for that year.

2. The sum specified in column (5) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to thirty eight crores forty two lakhs forty six thousand four hundred and seventy nine rupees shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to meet the amounts spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2014, in excess of the amounts authorised or granted for those services and purposes for that year.
