**NOTIFICATION**

The Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to declare **10<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 (Wednesday)** as Public Holiday (in case poll is held) on account of by-elections, only **to the voters of respective Gram Panchayat , Wards of Gram Panchayat / Wards of Panchayat Samiti / Wards of Zila Parishad where By- Elections to fill- up the casual vacancies in Panchayati Raj Institutions** in the State are scheduled to be held.

All Government Offices, Boards, Corporations, Educational Institutions and Industrial Establishments under Industrial Disputes Act and shops will remain closed on the said date **in the area of concerned Institutions** where by-election of PRIs are scheduled to be held. **This will also be a paid holiday to daily wages employees and also within the meaning of Section 25 of Negotiable Instrument Act 1881.**

Further, it is clarified that special casual leave may be given to those employees who are working in different places in the State but have a right to vote in concerned institutions (where By-Election to fill- up the casual vacancies in PRIs are scheduled to be held) **on the production of certificate** from the concerned Presiding Officer that the employee has actually cast his / her vote.




