Notification

In compliance of State Business Reform Action Plan 2021 under Ease of Doing Business, the H.P State Pollution Control Board, in order to simplify the existing regulating procedure and provides ease of doing business to the entrepreneurs, has decided to go for the facility of auto renewal of consent to operate under Section-25 of Water Act, 1974 and Section-21 of Air Act, 1981 to all green categories industries / projects (irrespective of the scale), subject to the following stipulations:

- Only those units shall be eligible for the application of auto renewal of consent to operate for further period which applies prior to 60 days before expiry of its existing online consent. For units whose CTO/CTO (expansion)/RCTO (expansion)/RCTO is expiring on 31 March 2022, they may apply for the auto renewal certificate up to 30.04.2022.
- This facility shall be availed by the green categories units for the individual applications of auto renewals of CTO/CTO (expansion)/ RCTO/RCTO (expansion) and not for the combination of any of the aforesaid application.
- The respective Green category units should not fall under the purview of EIA notification, 2006 or its amendment.
- The respective green category unit should have been registered in OCMMS for the existing last consent to operate.
- An 'Auto-Renewal Certificate' will be generated to the applicant/project proponent up on successful submission of complete renewal application (with requisite documents and prescribed processing fee).
- The application applied for the auto renewal of consent by the green category units shall be accompanied by the Environmental Statement (Form-V) for the last financial year.
- 7. The application of the green category unit shall be accompanied by an undertaking of no change in production capacity, pollution load and no legal proceedings pending at any court of law with regard to the operational activity, in the form of self-certification of the applicant to this effect in form –A (Annexure-I) in online format on OCMMS portal.
- The inspection of the industry shall be governed by the inspection policy framed by CPCB/HPSPCB/ State Govt. from time to time.

- i. In case, the inspection of the industry/project has already been made as per the protocol prescribed by the Board vide notification no. PCB(Engg)Bd. Mtg.(46)/2001-10594-10624 dated 10.01.2002 in the financial year in which unit is applying and no violation was observed during that inspection or compliance has been made subsequently, then there is no need of fresh inspection when application from such unit is received.
- ii. In case, the inspection of the industry/project has not been made as detailed at 8(i) and there is no complaint or violation proceeding pending against the industry/project, the Regional Officer shall ensure inspection for that financial year as per inspection policy to ensure the compliance from the unit.
- 9. The auto-renewal of Consents shall be subject to the prescribed standards/conditions which shall be verified by way of mode of inspections for the information as mentioned in point 8, besides verification of self-certified documents by the respective Regional Office of the State Board within a period of 30 days of auto consent generated by the system. In case any non-compliance is observed the State Board shall reserve the right to revoke the auto renewal certificate and the unit shall be liable for penal action as per Water Act, 1974. Air Act, 1981 and provisions of EP Act, 1986 including levy of Environmental Compensation as per norms prescribed by the Hon'ble NGT, as applicable.
- Copy of latest (six monthly) self-emission monitoring results from MoEF& CC, Govt. of India approved lab/ State PCB lab shall be attached with the application of auto RCTO for the compliance to the norms for air pollution control prescribed under EP Rules, 1986, as applicable.
- Copy of latest (six monthly) water monitoring results of SPCB shall be attached for the compliance to the norms for water pollution control prescribed under EP Rules 1986, as applicable.
- 12. Industry to submit self-certified undertaking on OCMMS.
- 13. This facility for Auto-Renewal Certificate' shall be available for all green category industries/ projects except the following where:
 - i. There is any change in the technical data including raw material/product/ manufacturing process/quantity of waste generation/pollution load/pollution control device(s)/mode of disposal of effluent or emission or solid waste or any other critical data. In such cases, the industry/project proponent shall be required to file application for issuance of CTE & CTO expansion as per norms.
 - The previous consent/authorization/registration application submitted by the industry/ project proponent has been refused by the Board;

iii. Any proceedings initiated by the State Board u/s 25, 26 or 33-A of the Water (Prevention Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, u/s 21, 31-A of the Air (Prevention Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and u/s 5 of the EPA (Protection) Act, 1986 against the unit, including directions issued if any, are pending.

The Procedure for filing the application shall be as under:

- The industry/project proponent shall submit application for auto renewal consent through OCMMS on http://hpocmms.nic.in.
- b. Auto-Renewal Certificate will be issued, based on submission of self- certified documents by the owner/director/managing partner/authorized responsible authority of industry/project, consent fee and sample analysis report (as in point 9,10) (as applicable), supported by an undertaking that no proceedings are pending against the industry/project proponent.
- c. The industries which are eligible for auto renewal have to apply through OCMMS in the prescribed self-certification Form A (Annexure-I) along with applying for auto renewal with essential documents.
- d. In case the information provided by the unit in the auto renewal of consent to operate application found false/incorrect during verification process, then auto renewal consent shall be rejected & will stand nullified. The unit has to apply for its consent through normal mode via OCMMS.

This scheme shall come into force with immediate effect.

Whereas, as per provision of Rule 3 of the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 "Producer" means person(s) engaged in manufacturing or import of carry bags or multilayered packaging or plastic sheets or like, and includes industries or individuals using plastic sheets or like or covers made of plastic sheets or multi-layered packaging for packaging or wrapping the commodity and "Importer" means a person who imports or intends to import and holds an Importer - Exporter Code number, unless otherwise specifically exempted, whereas "Brand owner" means a person or company who sells any commodity under a registered brand label

Whereas, as per Rule 9(2) of the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, "Primary responsibility for collection of used multi-layered plastic sachet or pouches or packaging is of Producers, Importers and Brand Owners who introduce the products in the market. They need to establish a system for collecting back the plastic waste generated due to their products. This plan of collection to be submitted to the State Pollution Control Boards while applying for Consent to Establish or Operate or Renewal."

Whereas, as per Rule 13 (6) "State Pollution Control Board or the Pollution Control Committee shall not renew registration of producer unless the producer possesses and action plan endorsed by the Secretary in charge of Urban Development of the concerned State or Union Territory for setting of plastic waste management system".

Therefore, after careful consideration and in order to ensure convenience of all parties concerned, in exercise of powers vested under *section-5 of 'The Environment Protection Act, 1986'*, it is directed that the action plan for the state of H.P. for plastic waste management system to be submitted by all industrial units falling under the definition of Producers, Importers and Brand Owners (PIBOs) as per Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 amended till date, in compliance with Rule 9(2) of aforementioned rule shall also be endorsed by Secretary, UD, GoHP (including PIBOs working in more than two States which have obtained PWM registration from Central Pollution Control Board) on the format enclosed as *Annexure-I*, at the time of applying for Consent to Establish, Operate and Renewal as well.

These directions are subject to amendments of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 as and when issued by Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

Whereas, as per the harmonization of classification of industrial sectors into Red. Orange, Green and White issued on 24-02-2021, Compressed/Refined Biogas (CBG) production from Biodegradable waste have been classified in Orange and White category in view of CPCB direction dated 30-04-2020.

Whereas, as per the information received from the Regional Offices of State Board an exercise for the assessment for the left out industrial sectors as per the Guidelines of Central Pollution Control Board was again conducted and was notified vide office order PC3/Consent Branch/Review meeting NOCs/2020-8696-8714 dated 23.09.2021.

Now, Whereas, CPCB vide letter no. CPCB/IPC-VI/ROGW 6686-6730 dated 22.09.2021 has informed that CPCB has revisited the categorization of CBG plants to promote the cleaner source of energy. PCB/Consent Branch/Review meeting NOCs/2020-25783-25805 dated 24.02.2021 had classified 86 nos. of industrial sectors in Red, 107 nos. in Orange, 69 nos. in Green and 137 nos. in White categories of Industries as per the revised criteria and guidelines of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) of 2016 based on the pollution potential.

Whereas subsequent directions from time to time were received from CPCB for adoption of newly categorized sectors and addition of any new or left over industrial sectors for categorization which is not listed in the categorization done by CPCB. In pursuance to the letter of Govt. of Himachal Pradesh vide No. STE-F (1)-3/2017 dated 14th July, 2017 vide which Pet Coke was approved as fuel by State Pollution Control Board vide Office Order No.HPSPCB/EIA Notification (Consent Branch)/2017-8189A dated 15.7.2017 for a year, the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh in continuation to above, conveyed its decision vide No. STE-F (1)-3/2018 dated 23rd August, 2018 to renew the approval for the use of Pet Coke and include Coal as an approved industrial fuel. In view of the direction of State Govt., State Pollution Control Board under section 2(d) and Section 19 (3) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 is hereby approve the use of Pet Coke and Coal as "an approved fuel" subject to following conditions:

- That it will be an approved fuel in case of the industrial units where consent under the provisions of Air Act, 1981 has been specifically issued for the utilization of the pet-coke and coal.
- All the industries irrespective of capacity of boiler/ furnace or any other device consuming pet coke or coal as a fuel in boiler/furnace or any other device shall have to provide caustic media wet scrubber/alkaline scrubber or any other suitable PCD, if not provided in existing pollution control devices.
- In case of the industries which have installed boiler/furnace of capacity greater than equal to 5 TPH or machinery/devices whose consumption of pet-coke is greater than equal to 5 ton per day, shall provide two stages of PCDs i.e. Venturi- scrubber followed by wet scrubber with online alkali/caustic dosing system and online SO₂ meter.
- The industries shall require installing, all the requisite air pollution control measures so as to achieve emissions as per standards for Sulphur dioxide (SO₂) emission as prescribed in Schedule-I of Environment Protection Act, 1986 as amended from time to time.
- The Industries will comply with all the conditions as laid down in the consent order issued under the Provisions of Air (Prevention and control of Pollution) Act, 1981.
- Pet coke and Coal using industries/unit shall submit the detailed characteristics of analysis fuel.
- If and when at any stage of operation of any industry, it is technically required that all the pollution control devices provided by the unit shall have to be interlocked, the same shall have to be complied by the unit.
- Pet-coke and Coal using unit/industries shall construct a barrier wall of adequate height along with the periphery of the premises where grinded pet coke is stored or pet-coke is grinded if applicable.
- This permission shall be subject to the final Outcome of Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment in case of M.C. Mehta Versus Union of India, J.A. No. 345 writ petition civil no. 13029 of 1985 or any other directions of Hon'ble NGT/CPCB, or any other Apex Court amended from time to time.
- All the industries which shall be using pet coke and coal as a fuel shall conduct the Ambient Air Quality Monitoring by any Laboratory approved by MoEF, Govt. of India, every month and results be submitted to the Pollution Control Board Office accordingly.
- On site and off site emergency plans shall be prepared duly approved by the competent authority and implemented in true spirit by the industries using pet coke and coal as a fuel.
- If in case at any stage of the operation of unit/ industry, the unit fails to achieve the prescribed norms of emission monitoring under EP Act, 1986 and Rules there under, the permission for the use of Pet Coke and Coal as a fuel shall deemed to be withdrawn and appropriate action under the provisions of Air Act, 1981 shall be taken.
- This permission shall be subject to any other condition/ directions imposed/ laid down by the State Pollution Control Board at any stage.
- Cement Industries which are using pet coke and coal as a fuel will meet at least 0.1% of their annual fuel consumption from pine needles, lantana and other forest based biomass whether in briquette form or otherwise and combustible material from Municipal Solid Waste or Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF) made from Municipal Solid Waste.

• This approval/ permission of the pet coke to be use an industrial fuel shall be valid for one year and will be reviewed after one year as per Government directions.

- In case of the industries which have installed boiler/furnace of capacity greater than equal to 5 TPH or machinery/devices whose consumption of pet-coke is greater than equal to 5 ton per day, shall provide two stages of pcds i.e. Venturi- scrubber followed by wet scrubber with online alkali/caustic dosing system and online SO₂ meter.
- The industries shall require installing, all the requisite air pollution control measures so as to achieve emissions as per standards for SO₂ emission with minimum height of 11 m from the ground as prescribed in Schedule-I of Environment Protection Act, 1986 as amended from time to time.
- The Industries will comply with all the conditions as laid down in the consent order issued under the Provisions of Air (Prevention and control of Pollution) Act, 1981.
- Pet coke using industries/unit shall submit the detailed characteristics of analysis of pet coke.
- The boiler/furnace shall operate with scrubber flow pump and with hotter system at the feeding system of the boiler, so as to
 ensure that the feeding system of fuel in the boiler should stopped once operational parameters exceed/fluctuates beyond the
 range. If and when at any stage of operation of any industry, it is technically required that all the pollution control devices provided
 by the unit shall have to be interlocked, the same shall have to be complied by the unit.
- Pet-coke using unit/industries shall construct a barrier wall of adequate height along with the periphery of the premises where grinded pet coke is stored or pet-coke is grinded if applicable.
- This permission shall be subject to the final Outcome of Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment in case of M.C. Mehta Versus Union of India, J.A. No. 345 writ petition civil no. 13029 of 1985 or any other directions of Hon'ble NGT/CPCB, or any other Apex Court amended from time to time.
- All the industries which shall be using pet coke as a fuel shall conduct the Ambient Air Quality Monitoring by any Laboratory approved by MoEF, Govt. of India, every month and results be submitted to the Pollution Control Board Office accordingly.
- On site and off site emergency plans shall be prepared duly approved by the competent authority and implemented in true spirit by the industries using pet coke as a fuel.
- If in case at any stage of the operation of unit/ industry, the unit fails to achieve the prescribed norms of emission monitoring under EP Act, 1986 and Rules there under, the permission for the use of pet coke as a fuel shall deemed to be withdrawn and appropriate action under the provisions of Air Act, 1981 shall be taken.
- This permission shall be subject to any other condition/ directions imposed/ laid down by the State Pollution Control Board at any stage.
- This approval/ permission of the pet coke to be use an industrial fuel shall be valid for one year and will be reviewed after one year as per Government directions.

NOTIFICATION

The H. P. State Pollution Control Board consequent to the decision taken vide Item No. 63.7 in its 63rd Board Meeting held on 04-07-2011 and in order to streamline the process of overall regulatory / executive action, with the purpose to secure the functions to prevent and control water and air pollution has decided that the following procedure shall be followed henceforth by all Regional Officers, Laboratory Incharge / Analysts and all concerned Officers/officials at Head Office with immediate effect:-

(1) On the observation of violation of norms for effluent / emission based on sample analysis report by the State Board Analyst / Regional Officer, in case of failure / non- compliance to norms, or conditions of consent, a Show Cause Notice under the Water Act, 1974 / Air Act, 1981 / Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 as the case may be will be issued, for giving opportunity to make compliance within time limit (keeping in view the gravity of violation, discharge of effluent/ emission) which may extend to maximum period of 120 days. During this period of opportunity the unit will be having sufficient time to implement the upgradation, augmentation and / or make improvements in the pollution control systems and compliance to conditions.

Following tasks shall also be concurrently ensured by the concerned Board officers/officials in case of non-compliance of norms for emissions/effluents:-

(i)	Within 45 days :-	Collection of minimum two samples by Regional Office concerned.
(ii)	Within next 45 :- days	Complete analysis of the samples collected and reporting of results to Regional Office concerned by the laboratory.
(iii)	Within next 10 :- days	Reporting by Regional office to Head Office with clear observations and recommendations for action required at Head Office.

(2) After completion of Step -1 above;

- (i) In case both the results of samples comply or conditions are complied, the Regional Office concerned shall send his report both to the Head Office and the industry, indicating compliance and the Show Cause Notice shall be deemed as withdrawn.
- (ii) In case both the samples taken after issue of notice as per Step-1 non-comply the norms or conditions are not complied, the State Board shall issue direction for power disconnection with immediate effect as per powers vested section 33-A of Water Act, 1974 or section 31-A of Air Act, 1981 as the case may be. The power disconnection shall not be restored by the State Board.
- (iii) In case one of the two samples taken as per Step-1, meets the norms and the other does not comply to the norms, then following tasks shall be completed within the following prescribed schedule:-
 - (a) Collection of One more sample within next 20 days by concerned Regional Office.

(PTO)

- (b) Within next 20 days:- Complete analysis of the samples collected and reporting of results to Regional Office concerned by the laboratory.
- (c) Within next 5 days: the Regional Office concerned shall send his report to the HQ indicating compliance or non-compliance w.r.t. Show Cause Notice under intimation to the unit.
- (3) After completion of Step 2- (iii) (a-c) above, again there would be two following possible situations:-
 - (i) The sample taken in Step 2–(iii) (a) meets the norms, the Regional Officer concerned shall send his report indicating compliance under intimation both to the Head Office and to the unit and the show cause notice shall be deemed as withdrawn.
 - (ii) The sample taken in Step-iii does not comply, the State Board shall issue direction for power disconnection with immediate effect as per powers vested under section 33-A of Water Act, 1974 or section 31-A of Air Act, 1981 as the case may be. The power disconnection shall not be restored.
- (4) Notwithstanding anything contained in the above procedure and the penalty of power disconnection prescribed and without prejudice to the rights of the Board for enforcement of the provisions of Water / Air Acts, with a view to prevent and control pollution; where it is apprehended by the Board, in case of exigency or situation posing imminent threat to any life forms, public at large and damage to environment, the State Board with powers vested in it under section 32 (1) (a-c) of Water Act, 1974 may issue directions with immediate effect, without following the aforesaid procedure.

All concerned shall follow and adhere to the prescribed procedure strictly.
