Statement of Legal Effect

Clause 2: This clause inserts the new section 68A in the Mortgage Act (Chapter 89), and the legal effect of that section is to limit the applicability of Part III of the Mortgage Act in relation to movable property upon coming into operation of the Secured Transactions Act, No. of 2023.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE MORTGAGEACT (CHAPTER 89)

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows: -

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Mortgage (Amendment) Act, No. of 2023.

Short title and date of operation

- (2) The provisions of this Act, other than the provisions of this section, shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may appoint by Order published in the Gazette.
- The provisions of this section shall come into 10 operation on the date on which the Bill becomes an Act of Parliament.
 - 2. The following new section is hereby inserted Insertion of immediately after section 68 of the Mortgage Act (Chapter new section 89) and shall have effect as section 68A of that enactment :- Chapter 89

15 68A. The provisions of part III of this Act "Application shall only apply to any movable property in so of part III to far as they are not inconsistent with the provisions of the Secured Transactions Act, of 2023, from and after the date of coming into operation of the said Secured 20 Transactions Act.".
