

Sri Lanka electricity provider to introduce payment plans

ECONOMYNEXT – The Ceylon Electricity Board will introduce payment plans for new connections and other services it provides, the power minister has said.

“It was decided to introduce payment plans for new connections and other services of CEB. Accordingly CEB management will notify of the new services, installment payment plans for electricity customers,” Minister of Power and Energy Kanchana Wijesekera said on X.

Wijesekera met with officials of CEB System control, Ceylon Petroleum Corporation and CEB at his Ministry where “2024 power generation plans, tariffs, costing of other services, oil pricing for power generation, weather forecasting and upgrading the facilities of the system control was discussed.”

A plan to cut Sri Lanka’s electricity tariffs after strong rainfall reduced generation costs is still pending. (Colombo/Jan31/2024).
